

Application Fees for the International Master Program IMSEIT

Dear applicant,

The international master program is free of tuition fee, but the application process as well as the bridging and German classes and accommodation support require the payment of the fees mentioned below. Payment details are communicated via the online portal KOPLA during the application procedure.

The electronic application is free of charge; all fees have to be paid only after your electronic documents have been accepted by the application committee.

Administrative Fee (mandatory)

Amount: 190€
Covering: Processing of paper documents

First Semester, pre-semester and German Classes Fee (mandatory)

Amount: 790€
Covering: Technical bridging classes, German classes, intercultural forum, technical excursions, books for German class, first semester fee, welcome events

Housing / Accommodation (mandatory if housing is booked)

Amount: 950€
Covering: Rent for month of September, deposit, service charge

Please transfer the fees to the following account. The listed amount does not include any possible transfer charges on either side, which would have to go on top and you have to bear the full costs. Without accurately identifying your application detail in the transfer reference field, we cannot credit you for any amount transferred and you will have to transfer the fee again. The receipt of all fees will be shown in KOPLA once we have processed it. Please allow up to 2 weeks before you send us a query by email. Keep a copy of your payment slip as proof that you transferred the fee.
