- Enrolment fee: this fee is required for the enrolment, it will cover the pre-semester courses as well as the first semester fee

Visa

- **Check** you local **visa regulations** and prepare paperwork
- **Apply for visa interview**
- Provide information about your APS registration in KOPLA (personal data section)
- Secure necessary financial means, if needed, arrange for a bank loan.

Make your visa appointment as soon as you are admitted

Finance

- All **students** are required to meet their own living costs while studying in Germany.
- You may use a **blocked account** to finance your studies in Germany.

pro tip: prepare documents by yourself

Pakistani students: Visa delays because of HEC Certificates - **act now!**



For a German visa your degrees need to be verified and certified

- book your interview early
- check your German embassy for information

Cost of living is often underestimated

You will need a **minimum** of **1100€** - if you have less, your study progress suffers

- Health insurance 140 €
- rent 370 €
- semester fee / month 64 € → **Deutschlandticket included!**
- food / living 553 €

Housing in Germany is off-campus

- **You will not find any rooms from abroad.**
- We have a contingent of 44 rooms: <https://mse.h-da.de/en/our-service/accommodation>
- The room rent of our contingent rooms is on average 291 - 410 Euros
- Please choose one student hall and apply for a room
- We will apply the first come first serve policy and will assign the cheapest room first
